Qualifications

- Manage Environmental and Regulatory contractors
- Compile various required regulatory submittals and oversee compliance notifications & reporting
- Maintain the Safety Data Sheet system and inventory
- Arrange and manage Driver Safety training program
- Manage and maintain all operational safety policies
- Manage covered drug and alcohol testing program
- Onboard new employees and manage PPE allotments for employees
- Understand current regulations and track proposed regulations to identify potential impacts
- Recommend and specify proper equipment and procedural needs to meet company goals
